Section 4.5

Treasurer Duties: Maintain responsibility for all financial matters related to the ABCD.

- Receive and give receipts of monies due and payable to the organization from all sources and shall deposit such funds in such banks or other organizations as are selected by the Executive Board.
- Make disbursements as authorized, approved, or amended by the Athletic Director and President or by the membership.
- Present a written financial report at each monthly meeting of the membership.
- File all forms necessary to maintain the exempt and non-profit status of the ABCD and file all the necessary tax reporting.

Our Mission

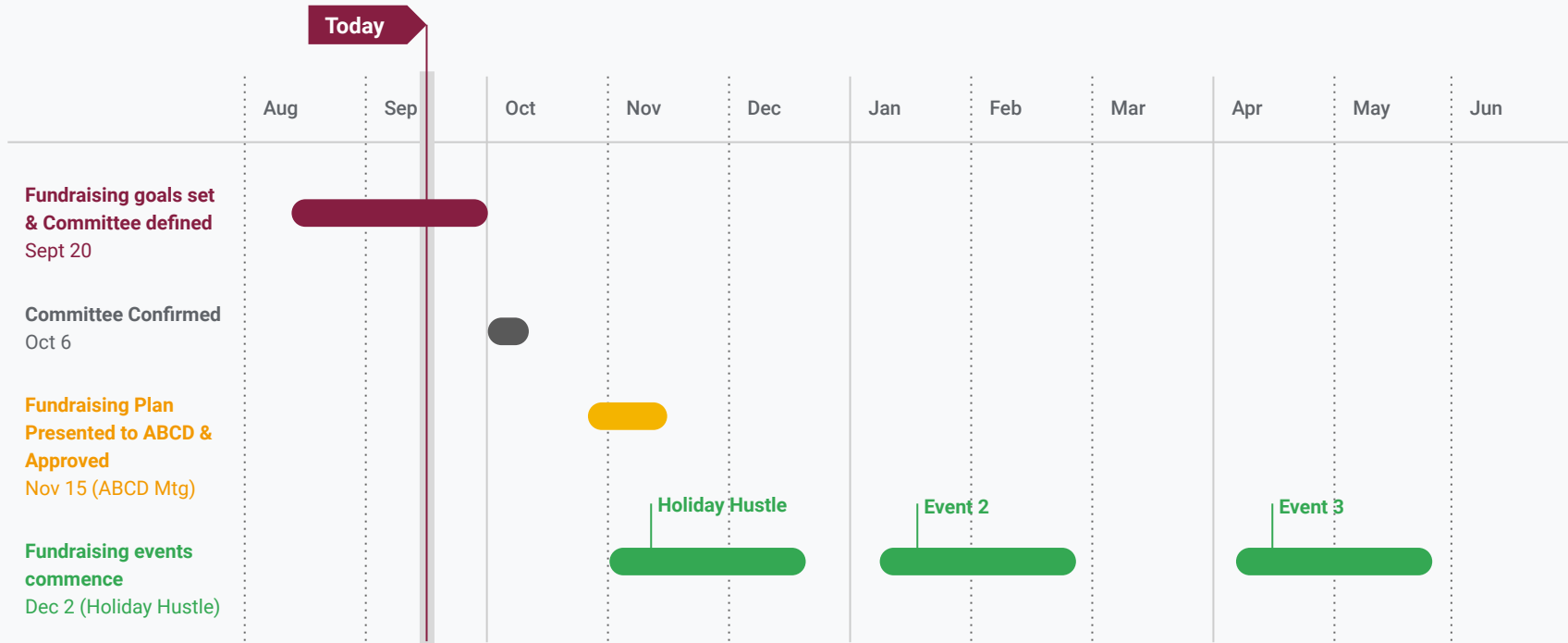

- Approx. 1 hour



As Dexter's Head Coach, Dexter Field Hockey has won **four state titles**, including three in the past four seasons (2014, 2019, 2020, 2022).

Keely also serves as **Executive Director of the Great Lakes Field Hockey**, is a **small-business owner/entrepreneur** (CrossFit Brighton) and **CrossFit competitor**. She has a BA in Education and a Masters in Social Studies Education from the University of Michigan, as well as a Masters in Sports Administration from Kent State University.

She was a **two-time captain of the University of Michigan field hockey team**, and assistant coach at Kent State University.
