Section 4.5

Treasurer Duties: Maintain responsibility for all financial matters related to the ABCD.

- Receive and give receipts of monies due and payable to the organization from all sources and shall deposit such funds in such banks or other organizations as are selected by the Executive Board.
- Make disbursements as authorized, approved, or amended by the Athletic Director and President or by the membership.
- Present a written financial report at each monthly meeting of the membership.
- File all forms necessary to maintain the exempt and non-profit status of the ABCD and file all the necessary tax reporting.

1 Overall Health

- Lower rates of anxiety and depression
- Lower amounts of stress
- Higher self-esteem and confidence
- Reduced risk of suicide
- Less substance abuse and fewer risky behaviors

(2) Academic Success

- Higher levels of academic achievement
- High school athletes are more likely to attend and graduate from a four-year college
- Improved teamwork, social skills, and social responsibility
- Improved life skills (e.g., goal setting, time management, work ethic, empathy, negotiation)

Stronger Community

- Adolescents who play sports are 8 times more likely to be physically active at age 24 than those who do not play sports
- A decrease in direct, indirect, and personal health care costs (collectively, up to \$28 billion per year)
