## Team Rep R\&Rs

## We can't do this without you.

Athletic Booster Club of Dexter (ABCD) Team Representative Expectations. Each Dexter Community Schools District Sport is required to provide one representative to serve on $A B C D$. Representatives provide input and assistance to $A B C D$ sport- can, and providing the financial support to our teams \& coaches to build a championship culture.

Team Reps should be confrmed by the start of the school year in the Team Rep Directory, including phone number and email addresses, and communicated to ABCD VP's Marie Richards and Allison Bishop.
Representatives should not do these things alone, they should work closely with your coaches and team parents/ families to complete your responsibilities.

## ABCD Representatives are expected to

1) Attendance: Attend all scheduled meetings ( $6-8$ meetings is customary) or appoint an alternate if they are not
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3) Ambassadorship: Proactively communicate with both your coaches and parents about the needs, benefits and activities of $A B C D$. Actively communicate with ABCD Officers on the needs and activities of your team and how ABCD can help support your team more effectively.
4) Fundraising: Throughout the year $A B C D$ will conduct fundraising activities (i.e. Trivia Night, Holiday Hustle, Membership sales, etc.). Team Reps will be expected to take on responsibilities to help create, promote, support and conduct fundraising events.
5) Raffle Licenses: If you are representing a sport that runs a raffle (e.g." "50/50"), ABCD will file for a Raffle License through the state of Michigan on your behalf as being a qualified non-profit is a license requirement by the state. Raffle license requests need to be made 60 days in advance of the start of the raffle/ season. $\$ 15$ per license will be charged for rafles with prizes under $\$ 500$. $\$ 50$ will be charged for raffles with prizes exceeding $\$ 500$.
6) Concessions Sports: If you are representing a sport that sells concessions, the following is expected from the representative.

## Concessions Lead

As a Team Rep for a sport that sells concessions you are the leader for your associated teams' concessions throughout the season. We depend on strong Team Rep leadership in order to successfully operate our concessions and maximize financial Rep Directory and communicated to Marie Richards \& Allison Bishop

- Attendance: Attend all scheduled meetings (6-8 meetings is customary) or appoint an alternate if they are not available (meetings are excused in the event your team has a contest on a scheduled meeting night).
- Ambassadorship: Proactively communicate with both your coaches and parents about the needs, benefits and activities of ABCD. Actively communicate with ABCD Officers on the needs and activities of your team and how ABCD can help support your team more effectively.
- Fundraising: Throughout the year ABCD will conduct fundraising activities (i.e. Trivia Night, Holiday Hustle, Membership sales, etc.). Team Reps will be expected to take on responsibilities to help create, promote, support and conduct fundraising events.
- Concessions Sports: If you are representing a sport that sells concessions, the following is expected from the representative.

## You are the Concession Lead

We depend on strong Team Rep leadership in order to successfully operate our concessions and maximize financial payouts back to our student-athletes, families and teams.

## Concession Staffing

- Team Reps will support concessions by acquiring sufficient volunteers for their team's home sporting events.
- $\quad$ Sign-ups will be managed via SignUpGenius - you can find the link here or on the $A B C D$ website.
- ABCD will send the SignUpGenius links to all Team Reps \& Coaches at the start of each season to help drive volunteers from parents outside of your team's sport but the final responsibility of staffing is that of the Team Rep.


## Food \& Beverage

Concessions will consist of popcorn, hot dogs, candy and pop. If you would like pizza, call Classic Pizza 48 hours in advance with the order and needed time of delivery and location. Payment not required at time of order or delivery.

## Team Starter Pack

Team Reps will be solely responsible for the contents of the Starter Pack throughout the season and must sign for its delivery \& return.

The Team Starter Pack will consist of:

- Start-up cash (i.e. Predetermined amount based on sport/ concession revenue)
- Concession key fob for entering the team concession stand.


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## Gameday Operations

1. Start-up: You are responsible for bringing start-up cash to concessions and/or ensuring CC machines are checked out*
2. Reconcile at shutdown: Fill out reconciliation sheet when concessions close

- Calculate revenue (Total Cash upon concession closure minus Start-Up Cash when concession opened)
- Complete money form (envelope)
- Complete sign-in sheet (put in envelope)
- Txt picture of completed reconciliation sheet to Marie Richards (734.497.4928) prior to place in safe - Drop into the safe

3. Report inventory needs by txting Marie 734.347 .4928 and/or emailing abcdconcessions@gmail.com
4. Safety check by ensuring concession stand is locked and all "hot" devices are turned off and unplugged
