


Fall: Mid-Season Varsity Football Concessions Revenue

WHAT'S CONTRIBUTING TO THE INCREASE?

Prices approx. 44%
 \$776 game more from raising cost of Soda/sports drinks from \$2.00 → \$3.00 Candy from \$1.50 → \$2.00

2. Credit Card Pmt approx. 39% \$685/ game from offering credit card pmt 25-29% of total transactions CCs

3. Increased throughput approx. 17% Shorter lines/ less time waiting increases transaction count on -13% attendance



Fall: Mid-Season All Concessions Financial Update

ONE-TIME COSTS

2023 Concession Start up Costs - \$9,143

\$6,348 - Equipment: Stand up warmer, hot chocolate machine, popcorn machine, 2 mini refrigerators, 3 coolers, food prep table

\$2,332 - Credit Card machines: Four Clover Flex POS Devices

\$463 - Misc Supplies: eg. broom, signage, warmer trays, cleaning supplies, etc.

RECURRING COSTS

Thru 9/18/23

Concession Expenses (food/drink/food supplies, excludes pizza) - \$8,908 Credit Card Processing Fees - \$256 (6.4%)

INCOME

Thru 9/18/23

Concession Income - \$16,441 (outpacing '22, 46% of revenue on 37% of events completed)

Cash - \$12,467 (76%) & Credit Card - \$3,974 (24%)

VOLUNTEERS

104 total volunteers across 10 events (17 remaining)

What is Education Fund of Dexter?

MISSION

To support educational programs for Dexter Community Schools not otherwise included in the schools operating budget.

GOAL

To provide meaningful financial support to address both immediate needs, as well as long-term initiatives in Dexter Community Schools.

IMPACT

Since 1985, the Educational Foundation of Dexter has awarded over \$1.1 million in teacher/district grants that support students from Pre-K to 12th Grade in the Dexter Community Schools.

The Rivalry Match



- Started in 2019 to raise money "off the field" based on the longtime "on the field" rivalry between Dexter & Chelsea
- \$150K+ raised for both EFD &
 CEF since its inception
- Fundraising commences at halftime w/ funds raised & "winner" announced at the game


