#### 2. Athletic Director Report

Welcome Mike. Mike has hired an Assistant A.D. - Kelly King from the University of Michigan. She is going to be a great addition to the athletic department and Dexter schools.

Mike answered many questions:

-Did you know the school only purchases safety equipment for the athletes. Not items like uniforms. Also pays for salaries of coaches, officials, entry fees, and transportation.

-Transportation has been a challenge for the last few years. We pay Getaway \$900 per bus when we use them. There is a big lack of bus drivers for the school and for sporting events.

-ABCD gives \$10,000 for pay to play scholarships that is 100% used and appreciated.





-At times we are short staffed for people helping to collect game entrance fees. We typically try to use NHS students and we pay them to help.

-Did you know you can pay an assistant coach out of team funds?

-Concession stand can have volunteers as young as 14, however the organization feels that 16+ and adults is really a better age to handle the busyness of the stand.
